

Listing Agreement

It is agreed that under this Agreement items assigned to InterART for sale are listed for a period of 6 months. During this time if the item is sold by InterART, InterART will be paid as per InterART's commission schedule for services rendered. It is also agreed that any expenses incurred by InterART on behalf of the Seller, i.e. shipping, insurance, advertising etc. will be reimbursed in full.

It is the responsibility of the Seller to provide all necessary documents, i.e. authentication, condition report, and if available, provenance if requested by the Buyer. Items can be listed without these documents, however it is good to remember that the better the documentation, the better the price.

It is also understood, that in case of willful deceit no money will be paid. The Seller also will be held responsible for incurred costs and damages. When account is settled, the item will be returned. However if account is not settled within 60 days of our notice, the item in question will be forfeited to cover the cost.

After sale contract has been signed, the Seller will make the item available to Buyer's shipper either at his premises or at a convenient storage location. Seller must obtain "Forwarder's Cargo Receipt", of which one copy is sent to InterART. Since all items are shipped "EXW" (on Buyer's risk and expense) this is where Seller's responsibility ends. Money will be paid in 30 days after "Forwarder's Cargo Receipt" is received by InterART, subject to Buyer's right to authenticate for a period of 30 days after receipt of shipping documents by InterART.
